BONNIE

Old cases, that my new job wanted me to throw out. I want to see how to get out of being a copy maker.

BONNIE

So you stole old cases?

CHRISTY

No. I took the trash out. Remember when I told you they liked my advice about a week ago.

BONNIE

Vaguely.

CHRISTY

If I read through these and come up with good ideas, maybe i'll get promoted.

CHRISTY GRABS A FILE FOLDER AND SKIMS THROUGH IT.

BONNIE

Good luck with that. Adam and I might need to plan for our Anniversary. Do you want to help with that too?

CHRISTY

I mean, I was happy enough just to attend the wedding. I didn't think I had to hold you're hand through the whole marriage.

BONNIE

Just making sure. You know how emotional you are when I forget about whittle ole Christy.

BONNIE REACHES OVER TO PINCH CHRISTY'S CHEEK. HER FACE IS PUCKERED. CHRISTY SWATS BONNIES HAND AWAY.

CHRISTY

Laugh it up, mom. I'll remember that when you want some emotional connections.

BONNIE CHUCKLES AND WE:

FADE OUT:

ACT ONE

SCENE A

FADE IN:

INT. CONVENTION CENTER - MEETING ROOM - DAY (D2)  
(Christy, Bonnie, Marjorie, Wendy, Extras)

BONNIE

Adam seems to think that the ride in  
the car home with burgers was our  
honeymoon. I want to go to a beach,  
see the sunrise, and be in amazing  
hotel room for our anniversary.

BONNIE GAZES TOWARDS THE CELEING.

WENDY

Sounds like you are going back to your  
childhood dream?

BONNIE

We all have one. What did you imagine  
when you were young, about marriage?

WENDY

I wanted to go see all the states and  
travel.

BONNIE

For your anniversary?

WENDY

Yeah. Traveling is one way to see new places and things. Marriage is a start to a new life.

BONNIE

Due to the fact that Adam isn't that mobile, I'll settle for a beach trip.

CHRISTY SCROLLS ON HER PHONE.

CHRISTY

I have to leave soon. They need more papers to be copied and thrown away.

MARJORIE

That must be so interesting. Do you get to do this in the room where they are discussing cases?

CHRISTY

No. They gave me a office with Copper in it. Said it was my assistant.

MARJORIE

Copper?

BONNIE SMILES AT MARJORIE.

CHRISTY

The copy machine. I had to give it a name. Since we work in the same room.

WENDY CHUCKLES.

BONNIE

Awe, that's cute.

CHRISTY ROLLS HER EYES.

CHRISTY

Might as well make it my friend. All  
the time I spend with it.

BONNIE

Just keep doing what you are doing and  
you will get the position you want  
eventually.

MARJORIE

Life is all about baby steps. You got  
to take it slow at first and gradually  
make your way up.

CHRISTY

Well I'm off.

CHRISTY STANDS UP AND WALKS OUT THE MEETING.

MARJORIE

So when do you plan on doing your  
anniversary?

BONNIE

As soon as I can get Adam in on it.

WENDY

Have you told him?

BONNIE

Not really what I want, but I  
indicated that I want to do something.

WENDY

Hope it works out for you.

BONNIE

It always does.

BONNIE GIGGLES AND WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE B

INT. LAW OFFICE - COPY ROOM - DAY (D2)  
(Christy, Male Attorney)

CHRISTY GRABS A FILE ON HER DESK AND WALKS OVER TO THE COPY MACHINE. SHE OPENS THE FILE AND READS OVER THE PAPERWORK. MALE ATTORNEY WALKS IN.

MALE ATTORNEY

Hey, we need those papers copied in the next hour.

CHRISTY

Okay. I looked through some cases yesterday and wanted to see if I can possibly sit in and analyze how they work?

MALE ATTORNEY

Oh yeah, let me run it by the guys and see what they think.

CHRISTY

Really?

MALE ATTORNEY

Not really. It takes time to become an attorney.



CHRISTY

I know. I just want to see how  
everything works.

THE ATTORNEY HANDS HER THE FILE FOLDER.

MALE ATTORNEY

Right now, just do the copies.

CHRISTY GRABS THE FILE FOLDER AND STARTS TO SCAN THEM. SHE  
GRABS ONE PAPER AND WALKS OVER TO HER DESK.

SHE SITS DOWN WHILE TYPING ON HER COMPUTER. HER EYES GET BIG  
AND WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE C

INT. BONNIE AND ADAM'S APARTMENT - LIVING ROOM - DAY (D3)  
(Bonnie, Adam)

ADAM ROLLS HIS WHEEL CHAIR TOWARDS THE KITCHEN. BONNIE WALKS DOWNSTAIRS IN HER SWIMSUIT CARRYING LUGGAGE.

ADAM

Am I missing something?

BONNIE

We are married now. Anything is possible.

ADAM

Meaning?

BONNIE

Let's go on our anniversary!

ADAM

I'm guessing burgers and the honeymoon, didn't count?

BONNIE

Seriously, Adam?

ADAM ROLLS BACKWARDS AND FORWARDS. BONNIE STEPS DOWN OFF THE STAIRS.

BONNIE (CONT'D)

Since I was a little girl I have  
dreamt of all my anniversaries.

ADAM

Okay. This is all too fast. I haven't  
even had my coffee yet.

BONNIE

Well when we went behind everyone's  
back and got married at first, that  
was really fast.

ADAM

We talked about that. That is why we  
planned a wedding and included  
everyone, after they lashed out at us.

BONNIE

Why do I have to argue with you, to  
get things I want?

ADAM

It's not an argument. I just think we  
need to sit down and plan this.

BONNIE WALKS IN THE KITCHEN. ADAM ROLLS OVER BESIDE THE  
COUCH.

BONNIE

Okay. Let's plan.

BONNIE SITS ON THE COUCH.

ADAM

Okay, we're doing this. Well, since we are going to look into our childhood dreams, I have to look back and think of what I envisioned.

BONNIE

That shouldn't be too hard.

ADAM

You wouldn't think so. I want to get some things for your dream. I have to run to the store.

BONNIE

Things?

ADAM

BONNIE LEANS BACK INTO THE COUCH AND CROSSES HER ARMS. ADAM GRABS HIS KEYS.

ADAM (CONT'D)

Are you going to wear that all day?

BONNIE

Until we leave.

ADAM CHUCKLES.

ADAM

You plan on wearing the same thing everyday until our anniversary? My beautiful wife. Just a great look into our future.

BONNIE SULKS.

BONNIE

Hurry up and get what you need.

ADAM ROLLS TO THE DOOR, OPENS IT, AND LEAVES.

WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE D

INT. BURGUNDY BISTRO - EVENING (D3)  
(Christy, Marjorie, Wendy, Extras)

WENDY LOOKS TOWARDS CHRISTY.

WENDY

How was work?

CHRISTY

The usual. Although, I ran across a  
case file they are working on right  
now.

MARJORIE TAKES A SIP OF HER DRINK.

WENDY

And?

CHRISTY

I went to my computer and remember a  
similar case I worked on when I was  
working at the other firm.

MARJORIE

You know thats a sign. I have heard of  
people who see similar things and go  
with their instincts and it moves them  
forward in life.

CHRISTY

Well if I could get my donkey of a  
manager to see my point of view on  
this case, I might be able to get a  
seat at their table.

THE WAITRESS WALKS OVER AND PUTS AN APPETISER ON THE TABLE.  
WENDY GRABS A CHIP AND DIPS IT IN THE SAUCE. MARJORIE DOES  
THE SAME.

MARJORIE

Sounds like a new turn in your life.

CHRISTY

I have to go home and look for the  
file I had at the last firm.

CHRISTY STANDS UP AND CARRIES HER FILE.

MARJORIE

Good luck.

WENDY

Hope it works out for you.

MARJORIE

Have you talked to Jill lately?

WENDY

Not really. I was going to reach out  
to her, since she missed the meeting.

MARJORIE PULLS OUT HER PHONE FROM HER PURSE AND SENDS A TEXT  
MESSAGE.

WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE E

INT. JILL'S HOUSE - LIVING ROOM - DAY (D4)  
(Jill, Tammy)

JILL WALKS AROUND IN A WHITE ROBE, A WHITE TOWEL WRAPPED AROUND HER HAIR, AND GREEN FACIAL MASK. TAMMY WITH THE SAME ATTIRE AND SITS ON THE COUCH.

TAMMY

These days beat going to AA meetings  
and jail memories, any day.

JILL

I could imagine. I see these jail  
shows all the time. They have similar  
situations in there, right?

TAMMY

Oh, yeah. They make spreads, girls  
nights, and ongoing parties every  
night.

JILL

Really? Sounds like a vacation. What  
are spreads?



TAMMY

Only the best food in jail! Want me to  
make one?

JILL'S FACE CRINGES.

JILL

Sure, I mean it's not the worse thing  
I've done.

TAMMY JUMPS UP AND RUSHES TO THE KITCHEN. JILL FOLLOWS.

INT. JILL'S KITCHEN - MOMENTS LATER  
(Jill, Tammy)

TAMMY STIRS THE INGREDINTS TOGETHER IN A BOWL. SHE GRABS TWO  
BOWLS FROM THE SHELF AND POURS SPREAD INTO THE BOTH OF THEM.  
JILL TAKES HER FORK AND CRINGES.

JILL

Here goes nothing.

SHE TAKES A TINY BITE. HER FACE LIGHTS UP.

TAMMY

Good, huh?!

JILL

Actually, yes! This is amazing.

TAMMY GIGGLES.

TAMMY

Told you.

JILL

We need to bring this to a meeting one  
day. See what the girls think.

TAMMY FROWNS.

TAMMY

That's kind of the reason I wanted to come see you. Me and bonnie went to see our old foster mother and she found out some things i'm not ready to talk about yet.

JILL PUTS HER FORK DOWN AND WIPES HER FACE.

JILL

Well i'm glad you came. Whenever you are ready to talk about it, I am here.

TAMMY

I guess it's about time to get my past off my mind. Tomorrow when we go to the meeting, I will open up and take advice from you and the girls.

JILL GRABS THE BOWL OF SPREAD AND POURS SOME INTO HER BOWL.

JILL

We are also going to have to bring this to the meeting. It is going to blow their minds.

TAMMY SMILES.

TAMMY

Until they know that this is the food they eat in jail.

JILL

Maybe we can keep that our little secret.

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TAMMY AND JILL WALK BACK INTO THE LIVING ROOM AND WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE H

INT. CONVENTION CENTER - DAY (D5)

(Bonnie, Christy, Wendy, Marjorie, Tammy, Jill, Extras)

BONNIE SITS IN HER CHAIR, STILL WEARING HER SWIM GEAR.  
CHRISTY AND THE OTHERS GAZE AT BONNIE.

CHRISTY

Any reason why you are in a swim suit?

BONNIE

Still waiting for Adam to take me on  
the beach for our anniversary. I told  
him about it the other day.

CHRISTY

And you are still wearing the same  
thing?

CHRISTY LOOKS DISCUSTED.

BONNIE

Yup. Don't plan on changing until I  
get my dream anniversary.

CHRISTY GLANCES OFF.

JILL

Okay. Well Tammy and I got together  
yesterday and she showed me a new  
meal.

JILL WALKS OVER TO THE BAR AND TAKES THE FOIL OFF THE BOWL.

TAMMY

You all have to try it. Jill was  
amazed on how good it is.

THE GIRLS ALL WALK OVER AND GET THEIR PLATES. THEY SIT BACK  
IN THE CIRCLE WHILE EATING.

WENDY

This is pretty good. What's it called?

TAMMY

A spread.

JILL

There goes our secret.

MARJORIE

Like what they eat in jail?

CHRISTY'S GAGS A LITTLE.

BONNIE

Well it sure fits our environment.

TAMMY

Just something I picked up while being  
in jail.

BONNIE

Thanks, Tam. It is good. Despite where  
you learned it from.

TAMMY

Okay, girls, I have to get this off my  
chest.

JILL LOOKS AT TAMMY AND HOLDS HER PLATE IN HER LAP.

TAMMY (CONT'D)

Only one person in this room knows  
what happened when I was younger, with  
my dad. I feel it is time to move  
forward and get it off my chest.

BONNIE GAZES OVER AT ATTENTION.

CHRISTY

We are all here for you.

TAMMY

My father took my mother's life in  
front of me when I was a kid. I was  
very hurt and thought if I didn't say  
anything about it that it would go  
away.

BONNIE RUBS TAMMY'S BACK.

WENDY

This is why we have this group. It is  
good to move forward and discuss these  
things.

TAMMY

I'm only ready to say what happened.  
I'm open to any advice.

TAMMY SOBS SILENTLY AS THE OTHERS RUSH OVER TO COMFORT HER.

FADE OUT:

END OF ACT ONE

ACT TWO

SCENE J

FADE IN:

INT. LAW OFFICE - COPY ROOM - (D6)  
(Christy, Male Attorney, Bonnie O.S.)

CHRISTY HOLDS A PIECE OF PAPER TO THE COPY MACHINE. THE MALE ATTORNEY WALKS IN. HOLDING ANOTHER FILE FOLDER.

MALE ATTORNEY

Hey Christy. I noticed one of the old files went missing, I remember asking you to throw it out the other day. Is there any way you still have it?

CHRISTY WALKS OVER TO HER DESK AND PULLS OUT A FILE FOLDER UNDER OTHER PAPER WORK.

CHRISTY

Yes, here it is . I looked through it and wanted to sit down and discuss with you and the rest of the attorney's some flaws I noticed.

THE MALE ATTORNEY GLANCES BEHIND HIM, WHILE SMIRKING AT ANOTHER ATTORNEY WHO WALKS BY, AND TURNS BACK TO CHRISTY.

MALE ATTORNEY

I thought that's what I heard you say the other day.

(MORE)

MALE ATTORNEY (CONT'D)

I talked to my manager about that, he asked me to make sure you didn't take the case elsewhere, and discuss it with anyone, because that would lead to termination of your employment.

CHRISTY GULPS. HER HAND SHAKES AS SHE HANDS HIM THE CASE.

CHRISTY

Uh, yeah, no. I didn't discuss it with anyone and I think I was looking at another case that had flaws in it.

THE MALE ATTORNEY PUT THE FILE UNDER HIS ARM PIT AND TOOK A SWIG OF HIS WATER BOTTLE.

MALE ATTORNEY

Okay, good. Off to make some changes to this today, lifestyles of an attorney an all. Back to filing papers for you.

HE HANDS HER THE NEW FILE FOLDER. SHE REACHES FOR IT AND WALKS OVER TO THE COPY MACHINE.

CHRISTY

Yeah, see you later.

THE MALE ATTORNEY WALKS OUT THE ROOM. CHRISTY RUSHES OVER TO HER DESK AND GRABS A WATER BOTTLE. SHE CHUGS IT DOWN. THEN TAKES DEEP BREATHS IN AND OUT.

CHRISTY (CONT'D)

BONNIE (V.O.)

Not today. I'm still putting my stuff  
together and getting ready for the  
trip. What's up?

CHRISTY

Oh, nothing I was just having a  
nervous breakdown.

BONNIE (V.O.)

Well, the girls should be able to  
guide you through it.

CHRISTY

Right. Thanks, mom!

CHRISTY ENDS THE CALL AND WALKS OUT THE OFFICE.

WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE K

INT. CONVENTION CENTER - (D6)

(Christy, Marjorie, Wendy, Jill, Tammy, Extras)

ALL THE LADIES GRAB THEIR CHAIRS AND PLACE THEM IN A CIRCLE.

WENDY

No Bonnie, today?

CHRISTY

Knowing her, she is probably wearing  
her swim suit and doesn't plan on  
going anywhere until she goes on her  
anniversary trip. Talked to her  
earlier and she said she is packing.

CHRISTY CROSSES HER LEGS AND LEANS BACK IN HER CHAIR.

TAMMY

We all have those kinda days.

MARJORIE

That's awesome! I can't wait to hear  
what they decided to do.

WENDY

I'm sure they are going to a beach. I  
mean why else would she be wearing a  
bathing suit?

MARJORIE

Never know with Bonnie. She might like a hotel room with a nice pool and be okay with that.

CHRISTY

Please, mom would have a shit show if she only went to a hotel room for her anniversary.

MARJORIE AND WENDY GIGGLE.

JILL

How are you feeling today, Tam?

TAMMY

Actually, really upbeat. I have come to the realization that we can't change the past but we can always hope for a better future.

JILL

Always. I'm glad we always have this support system to talk our problems out with.

TAMMY SMILES.

MARJORIE

I found a great play house for my kitties!

THE LADIES FOCUS THEIR ATTENTION TOWARDS MARJOIE. CHRISTY NERVOUSLY WALKS OVER TO GET SOME WATER.

WENDY

They say kitties are like our  
children.

CHRISTY WALKS BACK TO HER CHAIR AND SITS DOWN.

MARJORIE

Exactly. I found a nice new potty for  
them that uses WIFI, to clean it.

WENDY

Wow. Exciting. Technology is really  
progressing these days.

MARJORIE CHUCKLES. JILL LOOKS TOWARDS CHRISTY. CHRISTY  
FIDDLES HER FINGERS.

JILL

What's new with you, Christy?

CHRISTY LOOKS AROUND AT THE LADIES IN THE CIRCLE.

CHRISTY

I almost lost the easiest position at  
my job.

JILL

How do you manage to do that?

CHRISTY

I wanted a promotion, I stole a case  
file, and looked through it. I didn't  
think it was important, until the guy  
I work with came in looking for it.

TAMMY LOOKS TOWARDS CHRISTY.

TAMMY

If they are still working on that case, then yeah. I remember a girl in jail did something similar to that.

CHRISTY TAKES A SIP OF WATER. HER HAND SHAKES.

CHRISTY

Yeah, he told me that they would have to let me go if I discussed anything about that case to anyone.

JILL

Maybe he was just saying that so they didn't have to hear your input. You know men tend to be envious of women trying to advance in some careers.

CHRISTY SULKS BACK IN HER CHAIR.

CHRISTY

He sure did a good job. I don't plan on saying anything in regards to that case.

JILL

Don't stress over it, honey. Men are pigs. Lawyers are known for being good liars.

CHRISTY

Thanks, Jill. I needed to hear that. I tried to ask Bonnie for advice and she told me you all would be able to give me the support I needed.

JILL

Duh, we are here to discuss anything other than drinking.

TAMMY

THE LADIES HOLD UP THEIR WATER CUPS AND TAKE A SIP.

MARJORIE

WENDY

Yeah, I have some errands I need to run as well.

MAJORIE, TAMMY, AND WENDY TAKE THEIR CHAIRS AND PUT THEM UP.

CHRISTY

I'm going to see what Bonnie is up to.

JILL

Sounds good. I have a make over to attend to. Get some positive vibes going on today.

CHRISTY AND JILL TAKE THEIR CHAIRS AND PUT THEM UP AND WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE L

INT. BONNIE AND ADAM'S APARTMENT - LIVING ROOM - (D7)  
(Bonnie, Adam, Christy O.S.)

BONNIE SITS CRISS CROSS APPLE SAUCE ON THE COUCH. HER PHONE RINGS. SHE GRABS THE PHONE, ANSWERS, AND HOLDS IT UP TO HER EAR.

BONNIE

Hello?

CHRISTY (V.O.)

Just left the A.A. meeting. Still  
wearing your swim gear.

BONNIE LOOKS DOWN AT HER SWIM SUIT.

BONNIE

Yup. Waiting for Adam to get ready.

CHRISTY (V.O.)

He agreed to go?

BONNIE

Nope. He is in the shower and I set  
his swim outfit out on the bed.

CHRISTY (V.O.)

Well, the meeting went well. Just  
wanted to check up on you.

(MORE)

CHRISTY (V.O.) (CONT'D)

Jill told me that the guys might have been envious of me trying to advance in my career.

BONNIE

Sounds like you had an issue at work?

CHRISTY (V.O.)

Nothing to major.

BONNIE

Cool beans. I'll text you when we leave.

CHRISTY (V.O.)

Have a good trip.

BONNIE HANGS UP AND SETS HER PHONE DOWN. SHE PICKS UP THE REMOTE AND TURNS HER ATTENTION TO THE BATHROOM DOWNSTAIRS.

ADAM (O.S.)

Um, honey? Is this what I'm wearing today?

BONNIE CHUCKLES.

BONNIE

Yup.

ADAM (O.S.)

Oh, how I love the fact that everything you do, I automatically have to agree with.



BONNIE

That's the married life. Once you understand the wife is always right, we will be so much happier.

ADAM WHEELS OUT THE BATHROOM IN HIS SWIM SUIT.

ADAM

I picked up some things for the trip the other day. Plus, I booked a nice room on the beach for us.

BONNIE SPARKS UP AND JUMPS IN ADAMS LAP.

BONNIE

See that's why I married you. I don't have to bitch at you for more than a day until you give me what I want.

ADAM GROANS AND BONNIE KISSES HIM ON THE CHEEK.

ADAM

I'll grab the keys. My stuff is already in the car. Do you have your stuff packed? Or, do you just plan on wearing that the entire trip?

BONNIE RUSHES UP STAIRS AND BRINGS DOWN TWO LARGE SUIT CASES.

BONNIE

Nope. I was already packed.

ADAM

Did you bring the whole house?

SHE PLOPS ONE BAG ON TOP OF HIM. HE EXHALES.

BONNIE

Nope. Just the kitchen. We got to eat,  
while we are there.

ADAM FROWNS WHILE BONNIE WALKS BEHIND HIM. THEY EXIT THE  
HOUSE AND WE:

CUT TO:

SCENE M

FADE IN:

INT. LAW OFFICE - ATTORNEY MEETING ROOM - (D8)  
(Male Attorney, Manager, Extras)

THE LAWYERS SIT AT THE CIRCLE TABLE IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROOM.

MANAGER

How's everything going with the new  
copy girl.

THE MALE ATTORNEY SIPS ON HIS WATER BOTTLE AND CHUCKLES.

INT. LAW OFFICE - HALLWAY  
(Christy)

CHRISTY WALKS TO THE DOOR, HOLDING HER FIST UP, ABOUT TO KNOCK. SHE LEANS TO THE DOOR AND PUTS HER EAR TO THE DOOR.

INT. LAW OFFICE - ATTORNEY MEETING ROOM - DAY  
(Male Attorney, Manager, Extras)

MALE ATTORNEY

She tried to give me advice on a case.

HE GRABS THE FILE FOLDER AND BEGINS TO SHRED IT IN THE SHREDDER NEXT TO HIM.

MANAGER

Guess she wants a promotion? The copy  
room must not be a big transformation  
from her last job.

MALE ATTORNEY

Who knows. I told her that she could  
loose her position if she snoops  
around in any of our old cases.

THE MEN SHARE CHUCKLES.

MANAGER

Good call. I remember the days I had  
to claw my way up to the top.

MALE ATTORNEY

Yeah, well I'm next up and until then  
she needs to stick to her day job.

THE MALE ATTORNEY FINISHES SHREDING THE PAPERS.

INT. LAW OFFICE - HALLWAY  
(Christy)

CHRISTY LEANS AWAY FROM THE DOOR AND GASPS. SHE LOOKS AT THE  
COPIES SHE MADE FOR THE MALE ATTORNEY, HOLDS THEM TO HER  
CHEST, WITH A FROWN ON HER FACE, WHILE STORMING OFF.

INT. LAW OFFICE - COPY ROOM  
(Christy, Jill V.O.)

CHRISTY PULLS HER PHONE OUT FROM INSIDE HER DESK. SHE MAKES A  
CALL TO JILL AND HOLDS THE PHONE UP TO HER EAR.

JILL (V.O.)

Use the cucumbers. I love how they  
make my face feel refreshed.

CHRISTY

Um, hello?

JILL (V.O.)

Sorry, Christy. I am at the Spa.  
What's up?

CHRISTY

You were right!

JILL (V.O.)

I'm always right, but about what  
though?

CHRISTY

The attorney. I just over heard him  
shredding the papers I gave him. He  
doesn't think I should advance.
